CASE 1

The laundry has fallen

Drying wet laundry on the stove certainly dries it well. But it can also come at a great price in the form of a fire.

Dried laundry is destabilized by updrafts from the stove. Hang your laundry away from the stove to dry.



CASE 2

Gasoline is mixed in the cartridge tank

When a kerosene-fueled stove is filled with gasoline, the vaporized gasoline component leaks out and burns explosively. This is a very dangerous act. To prevent this, do not store gasoline and kerosene in the same place. Writing "No gasoline!!" is also effective.

Keep them separate!

CASE 3

Kerosene spilled on the hot stove

Cartridge tank type stoves often cause spillage of kerosene inside.

There are various reasons for this. You neglected to switch off when refueling, the cap was not closed tightly, or you fell while holding the tank.

It's still hot right after the fire is extinguished. Extinguish the fire before refueling, and be careful.
